PREPARE FOR THE 2022-23 FAFSA

You can simplify completing the 2022-23 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)! Get your FSA ID (which will be used to sign into the FAFSA website) and gather all the documents needed to complete the form.

CREATE AN FSA ID

- Go to StudentAid.gov.
- Click on "Create Account" on the right.
- Enter your personal information.
- Create a user name and password.



TIPS AND REMINDERS

- Both the student and one parent will need an FSA ID.
- A student and parent *cannot* share an FSA ID or the email address associated with the FSA ID.
- A student should use an email account they will have access to after high school (don't use a high school email address).



GATHER DOCUMENTS

- Student and parent's Social Security numbers
- Student driver's license number
- Alien Registration number (if not a U.S. citizen)
- 2020 federal tax information for students and parents, including tax returns and W-2s
- Records of untaxed income
- Information on cash, savings and checking account balances, investments
